Annual Report

Education is the learning of facts, training of minds to think and a medium to mould millions of minds. The role of a teacher is pivotal and demanding which needs persistent efforts for the improvement. At Holy Child Public School, we have been working very hard to groom overall personalities of the students. The annual report of the school is presented here briefly, the details of which you will find in the subsequent pages.

ACADEMICS

The year 2017-18 had been an eventful year for us. With the great efforts of our teachers, hard work of students and co-operation of the parents we successfully attained our endeavors.

In 2018 CBSE Board Examination, VABHAV KADIYAN scored 98.8% marks in aggregate securing 1st position in school. We are happy to inform you that he also topped District Faridabad in Class 10th.

A total number of 157 students appeared in class 10th CBSE Examination. Out of these 19 students scored more than 95% marks in aggregate while 42 students scored more than 90% marks in aggregate.

The highest marks achieved in English were 100, Maths 100, Science 100, Sanskrit 99, Social Science 99 & Hindi 99.

In Class 12 out of 152 students Bhumi Chaudhary topped the school with 96% marks in the Non-Medical stream. Sanjana Singh topped the Medical stream with 93% marks in aggregate and Aditi Verma topped the Commerce stream with 95.6% aggregate. Besides this 152 students secured 90% and above in various subjects.

11 students of our school bagged gold medals in International Maths Olympiad and 11 in National Science Olympiad.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities have vital role to play in a student's life. They help in the development of various domains of mind and personalities such as intellectual development, emotional development, social development and moral development. Hence equal importance is given to co-curricular activities.

Our 8 students participated in Shloka and Chaupai recitation from which 4 students of our school got selected for District Level and won the first position. At Bharat Vikas Parishad National Group song competition and Folk Song our students bagged 2nd position at District level, 1st position at State Level and 3rd position at National Level. Ritika Harshi bagged 1st position in Poster Making, Mantra Bhardwaj bagged 2nd position in Best Dramebaaj and Geet Goel bagged 3rd position in Fancy Dress Competitions in District Level at Bal Bhawan.

The dance troupe of Holy Child Public School bagged 1st position at District Level, Zonal Level and State Level in Group Dance Competition at Bal Bhawan, Shruti S. Kumar added feather in the glory of the school by bagging 1st position at District Level and Zonal Level in Solo Dance Competition

Our Computer techies participated in 'Evolve'-Annual Tech Fest at DAV Sec 37 and made the school proud by bagging 2nd position in "Scratch-O-Mania' and -'Digi-Dhan' (Tech-Rangoli) and 3rd position in "Digi-Writer' events.

SPORTS

Sports is an integral part of the school curriculum. Students have been producing remarkable results year after year under the able guidance of the expert coaches.

Our Table Tennis, Volleyball, Gymnastics, Karate, Lawn tennis, Yoga, Swimming, Taekwando and Wrestling teams performed marvellously at different levels and brought laurels to the school.

The piper band of HCPS made us proud through its performance. Our Band got selected for All India National Level School Band Competition at Tyagra; Sports Complex New Delhi by defeating different teams at Haryana State Level Inter-School and Northern Zonal Level Inter School Competition.

It was indeed a very proud moment for the school.

# An Eye Opener



provide the students with the knowledge of traffic rules and to make them aware of Heroes of the past. We believe that it promotes active learning through direct personal experience.




