

## J.K. JAIN SCHOLARSHIP

**In order to encourage and facilitate recognition to students who are academically strong, the school offers the platform of J.K. Jain Scholarship through a written test assessment at Class X for students for Class XI & XII which is:**

- announced to parents and students through a detailed circular well on time and a newspaper advertisement in national dailies.
- accompanied by clear instructions on subjects, syllabus and form of questions to be asked.
- open for voluntary participation.
- holding scholarship exams at regular intervals throughout the academic session, offering multiple opportunities for participation.

**Students qualifying with commendable performance** and taking general positive behaviour feedback as well as co-scholastic profile of student into consideration, they are short-listed for interaction with J.K. Jain Scholarship Committee headed by Principal and awards are declared for Class XI & XII.

The qualifying criteria for continuation of J.K. Jain Scholarship Scheme for Class XII is a score of minimum **75% in the Annual Examination**.

In addition, the **Class X CBSE Board Exam Result is also taken towards grant of J.K. Jain Scholarship**, irrespective of scholarship awarded or not awarded through written assessment test. This is an additional opportunity to become eligible for award of scholarship for students who, after passing Class X are moving to Class XI.

**The J.K. Jain Scholarship is also awarded to students posting outstanding performance consistently in sports at national and International level in Govtt. recognised sports events.** This is done through receipt of application at the close of a session for next session and is subject to continuation of high level performance in the forthcoming session as well.

## HOLISTIC EDUCATION

Keeping the class size very manageable to ensure effective academic tutoring and relationship building, our air-conditioned smart classrooms, are happy spaces. (Nur -XII)

Each classroom is equipped with an interactive board. Each class maintains and runs its own class library, in addition to accessing the main library.

Leadership, healthy exchange of views, responsibility for action are encouraged through circle time activities. There is conscious focus on intra-class activities and class wise assemblies to promote 100% participation of students.

Students learn by doing, by breaking barriers of inhibition and trusting those around them. The school actively participates in Inter - DPS events, inter- school events and invites other schools as well for various competitions.

Students are encouraged to participate in Olympiads, Aryabhata, NTSE, ASSET, KVPY and other competitions. Tours, visit to heritage sites, museums, exhibitions etc. are a regular feature of the school's curriculum.

**Specialised Centre for Differently Abled and Special Needs students of the school and general community, called GRASP Centre (Growth Remediation And Support Programme).**

The Foundation Stone of GRASP Centre was laid by **Shri Kanwar Pal Gujjar, Honorable Education Minister of Haryana on August 15, 2020.** The Centre will be functional in a year and aims to provide **specialized services of Therapist, Counsellors, Special Educators to provide** a socially, physically and emotionally inclusive environment to the differently abled children of Haryana.

## Galloping Horses

## Discovering New Perspectives (DNP)

Under the aegis of DNP, DPS Greater Faridabad launched the programme for parent-school partnership on December 14, 2013 as an effort to foster stronger relationship between the school and the home, focusing on the child as the loci of both the parent as well as the school. On regular basis, parents are provided with guidance on sensitive issues of relevance. Through DNP and frequently conducted workshops, the school aspires to be a resourceful medium of support to parents through education and empowerment necessary for sound parenting.



## Scholar Badge Programme

Keeping academic excellence at the forefront of our endeavours, we have a well designed programme to celebrate scholastic achievements.

A Scholar Badge accompanied by a Certificate of Merit, is awarded for academic excellence based on the whole year performance with minimum criteria as detailed below:

- a) IV - X - 80% and above in aggregate
- b) XI and XII - 75% and above in aggregate

Three consecutive years of winning the Scholar Badge from class IV onwards will make a student eligible for the Blue Blazer Award. Six consecutive years of a Scholar Badge will make a student eligible to receive a Blue Tie. Eight consecutive years of a Scholar Badge will make

a student eligible to receive a Gold Medal. Certificate of Merit shall be awarded to students securing highest & second highest CGPA in all sections of a particular class (IV - IX). This certificate of merit will not be curtailed by any considerations of number of winners. Certificate of Merit shall be awarded to students for 100% attendance for classes Nursery-XII. This honour is a coveted one and students strive to win the Scholar Badge that comes with a specially monogrammed winter blazer pocket.

## I Read... I Lead Programme

"I Read... I Lead", is an active reading programme operational for our dipsites. It provides a wonderful incentive for our students to develop literary skills and ability to read with expression. For students of Class I, our core idea is of getting hands-on library experience and mastering basic reading skills. For Classes II - VIII, students select books from the suggested list of books (as per their age and reading interest) and read and maintain a reading record.

Various incentives which students of Classes II to XI receive are:

- For 10 books read at the earliest - a Special Bookmark
  - For 20 books in an academic year - a Bronze Reader Badge


## Smart Classrooms

The **"Know Your Roots"** project intends to encourage our students gain knowledge about India in all its hues and colours.







## ATL (Atal Tinkering Lab)




### HEY JUNIOR
