

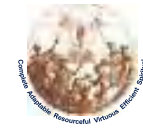

1972

Capturing our Heritage

1978

Establishing the first stepping stone into the field of education, Century Tagore School envisioned to develop quality educational standards in Delhi. It is the first private school set up in the locality.



1980-82

Our first batch of students received appreciation from community leaders for the growing standards of education in the school.



1979

The school is established as a primary school. These pictures were taken on the 15th of August 1979 showing students' enthusiasm towards their heritage.



1984-86

A proposal to establish a Senior Secondary School was approved.

1983

With our sincere commitment towards introducing quality education, the school soon gained popularity and within a few years the student population grew to 800.



1987

This year marked the establishment and the foundation of Lancers Convent, a Senior Secondary School affiliated to CBSE.



Lancers Convent was one of the first CBSE affiliated schools to start its operation in the 1980s.

1988

The Annual Celebration of the year 1988 was graced by the Chief Minister of Delhi.



1990-92

With over 3,000 students and over 100 teachers, the school has proven its quality education.



Lancers became one of the most desirable schools in the region.

1996-99

The school received a State Level Citation from the Ministry of Education for the model paper organized by the National Foundation of Indian Engineers.



The school was awarded a certificate by the Indian Red Cross Society, Delhi.

1993-95

The school's Eco Club received the Indira Award, a national award constituted by the Centre for Science and Environment, Delhi.

1989

Lancers Convent won a prize in 'On the Spot Poetry Competition' organized by Hindi Rashtriya Sangh.

2001

Lancerians received three (3) Gold Medals at the District Level Delhi Talent Search meet.



The school was also awarded a prize in the Radio Quiz, broadcasted by All India Radio (FM).

To establish world-class quality education and to further expand the growth of Lancers, Lancers International School (An IB World School) was founded.

Our faculty members personalize their teaching to each child's learning style. They apply best practices to create classroom conditions that help increase attentiveness and information retention. This practice helps reduce stress and makes for happier learners.

We've created a harmonious learning environment where our faculty members know their students both as people and as learners. The structure of our academic program lays a strong emphasis on self-study and understanding a topic in great depth. Our students are encouraged to share their opinions in class and feel inspired to back them up with facts and logic.

LIS offers a strong international curriculum at all levels:

- The International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (Foundation to Grade 5)
- The International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (Grade 6 to Grade 10)
- The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (Grade 9 -10)
- The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (Grade 11-12)

Our faculty challenge students and give them opportunities to excel throughout their time at LIS. Through project-based learning opportunities, LIS students build skills in collaboration and innovation as they work towards common goals. As a result, students are intellectually stimulated and graduate with knowledge of their own strengths, and a deep love for learning, which is something they carry with them for the rest of their lives.

Early Years Preschool to Kindergarten

For our youngest learners, every moment is filled with new ideas, wonderings, and exciting discoveries. When our early learning students explore our campus, garden, watch kites soar in the wide sky or build imaginary words, they discover that what they say, think and do matters.

Two-year-old preschool students and four-year-old pre-kindergarten students attend our early learning programme daily from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Throughout the day, our young learners work independently and in small groups, visit hands-on exploration stations, stretch their muscles during two daily outdoor play times and take field trips throughout the year. Our concept-based curriculum allows kids to connect, explore, and relate through their own interests, and by listening to those interests, we can better provoke their thinking.

The curriculum includes daily language classes, literacy, mathematics, science, social studies, music, and daily perceptual motor skills development.

Primary School First Grade to Fifth Grade

Primary school at LIS is a place where the foundation of learning takes hold, and where we have the rewarding job of fostering and challenging students to maintain their curiosity and creativity while extending their self-confidence and self-advocacy. A daily schedule of core subjects in reading language arts, mathematics, world languages, science, and social studies is punctuated by specialist classes in art, music, physical education, swimming, technology and library use. Experiential learning outside the classroom through field trips and community service inspires students and enriches the curriculum.

From the earliest grades, LIS students are active learners, students learn to analyze and question across subject areas, and learn to express themselves in writing, presentations, and discussions. They understand where they are in their learning journey, what their learning targets are, and what it will take for them to reach the next steps. Our students take risks and learn from failure in a community of acceptance, preparing them to meet and surmount high academic standards.

We recognize the importance of friendships and working cooperatively, and foster the development of skills that contribute to every students' personal and academic success. Value programs are integrated into the culture and program of each grade level and LIS counselors are matched with students for three-year cycles to provide personal support and facilitate building emotional competencies.





M

iddle School Sixth Grade to Tenth Grade

Our middle school students have the space to grow and find themselves in a unique and welcoming environment guided by teachers who particularly enjoy working with this dynamic age group.

The core middle school academic courses of reading language arts, social studies, math, science, physical education, health, and world language include project-based learning to provide real-world experiences that allow students to conceptualize, apply, and reflect new learning. Elective courses of band, strings, choir, art, drama, dance, music creation, IT, video, tech, strategic learning, and cooking are just a few of the exploratory and innovative programs that capitalize on students' interests and extend their learning. Middle school opportunities for leadership and service are provided to aid in developing a sense of responsibility and care for our extended community.

High School Eleventh and Twelfth Grade

We believe education should be more than the accumulation of knowledge. Learning at LIS is a process of discovery and transformation through pursuing individual passions and encountering new ways of viewing the world.

Research shows that students learn best when they are connected to the life of their school and to the adults there who guide them. Every high school student belongs to a small group, and has an advisor who mentors them, helps them track their progress, set goals, discuss and solve learning issues, and build on their capacities to take responsibility for their learning.

Counselor work exclusively helps high school students in their successful transition to high school, advising them to develop an appropriately rigorous course of study and encouraging them to pursue their non-academic interests. Tenth, eleventh, and twelfth grade students are assisted in the university application process by experienced counselors who are highly regarded in the university admissions community.







Sports

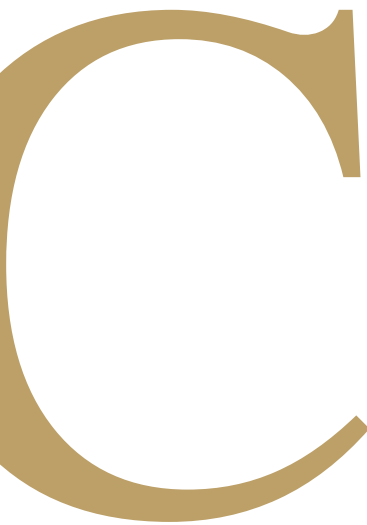
Participation in sports enhances the life of every student at LIS, whether that applies to being more disciplined and a team player or learning how to have fun on the field and otherwise. With regular games throughout the week, a choice of over 25 sports, world-class facilities and coaches, and the chance to regularly compete in inter-school matches, students are kept healthy and active throughout their stay at LIS.

Under the guidance and support of some of the best coaches in the world, students develop their skills and competence in a sport of their choice. Through competitive games such as basketball, golf, boxing, gymnastics, shooting, cricket, football, hockey, tennis, students learn teamwork and cultivate resilience and self-discipline.

With the most advanced indoor fitness and sports area, students have the option to participate in ice skating, squash, swimming, judo, archery and aerobics. O-Curricular Activities

Life at LIS goes beyond being academically strong. It focuses on a child's overall development by exposing students to a range of experiences through travel, music, art, theatre, sports, speech and debate, and a range of social clubs that cover a broad spectrum of interests.

Research has shown that integrating the arts throughout the curriculum enhances learning. Presenting an art project to an audience, and experiencing stage time through drama, song, and dance gives students a medium for self-expression and boosts their confidence. Both fine and performing arts are interwoven throughout our curriculum, providing excellent options for students of many interests.

Instrumental instruction begins at an early age and a majority of our students learn to play an instrument. The keyboard is taught to all Grade 3 students to help set a strong musical foundation. Students from Grade 3 to 8 have the option to choose from 12 musical instruments including the flute, clarinet, oboe, bassoon, trumpet, french horn, baritone horn, trombone, guitar, bass guitar, piano and percussion. Moreover, additional classes are available to study composition, music technology, jazz improvisation and music theory.







Boarding

Going to a boarding school can be one of those pivotal moments in life - the one where for the first time, we put ourselves into an unknown territory and come out victorious. We understand that it's important to give our students a space that's not only relaxed and homey, but also welcoming and supportive. It's a place where students can be themselves and reach out to one another or their dorm parent for support and comfort.

Each dorm room is snug and comfortable, and our students personalize it with pictures, books and other paraphernalia of their choice. Every block has its own lounge area where students can sit-back, relax, read, watch television or chat with their peers. The dorm parent is more a friend to the students and makes sure that they are happy and doing well at school. Moreover, students can openly chat with their dorm parent about their challenges, if any and overcome them together.
