Learning with Tablets and Laptops

Students and teachers have access to tablets that are used on a one-on-one basis to research, explore and create. There are bi-weekly slots during which students learn to examine different content and work on concept-specific interactive books, games and projects.

Students also have access to the Laptop Lab where each student works on a structured ICT curriculum. Students create assignments and several projects as a part of their coursework. They also learn to 'Code' through the 'Scratch' programming language.
