# LESSONS FOR LIFE: OUR REGGIO INSPIRED Approach


Reggio Emilia has created an educational system that ranks amongst the best early years education programmes in the world. This approach has attracted worldwide attention of educators and researchers. At Vivero, we have been strongly inspired by this approach. We view every child as strong, powerful, rich in potential, driven by the power of wanting to grow and nurtured by adults who take this drive towards growth seriously.

Our vision of the child as a competent learner has led to a strong child-directed curriculum model. Children are encouraged to learn about themselves and the world around them through investigation and discovery. The curriculum at Vivero is grounded in current research and developments in the field of early childhood education. In particular the work of The Centre on the Developing Child and HGSE at Harvard University, the International Baccalaureate (IB) and the Infant and Toddler Centres of Reggio Emilia has deeply influenced our curriculum. Our academic leadership team has visited these centers of excellence and customized Vivero's curriculum to ensure effective instruction in our Indian context. Fundamental to our beliefs is the importance of all round development of the child — emotional, physical, cognitive and social.

Our methodology has a strong belief that children learn through interactions with others, including parents, staff and peers as partners in a friendly learning environment. The teachers act as researchers - always reflecting and researching best educational practices. At Vivero educators are constantly evolving and see themselves as a provocation and reference point for learning.

Key features of Vivero International's early childhood education and care program include:

- Rich learning environments filled with authentic experiences and open-ended materials
- Documentation which is used as an authentic assessment and advocacy of children's learning
- Child directed and teacher framed curriculum
- Collaboration of teachers, parents and the school community to create a holistic learning experience for the child





# A HUNDRED Languages

Probably the most well-known aspect of the Reggio Emilia Approach is 'The belief that children use many, many different ways to show their understanding and express their thoughts and creativity'. There are a hundred different ways of thinking, of discovering and of learning. These may be through drawing and

sculpting, through dance and movement, through painting and pretend play, through modelling and music and each one of these Hundred Languages must be truly valued and nurtured. These languages or ways of learning are all a part of the child's growth curve. Learning and play are not separate.

Vivero emphasizes hands-on discovery learning that allows the child to use all their senses and all their languages to learn. We celebrate the joy in discovery as we prepare children to be creative, confident learners and citizens.

At Vivero, we don't teach 'classes', we engage with individuals. The underpinning belief is that teaching is not a one-size-fits-all automated process, but an intentional and purposeful endeavour.

Our teachers observe each child, and tailor instructions to suit the individual needs of that child.

Our educators continously assess a child's knowledge and structure specific learning environments and experiences, which support that child's progress towards identified goals. These experiences are play-based, hands-on and experiential in nature. They ensure deeper enjoyment whilst facilitating an understanding of concepts and ideas.



## TEACHERS

"The teacher who is indeed wise does not bid you to enter the house of his wisdom but rather one who leads you to the threshold of your mind." - Khalil Gibran

We take great pride in the exceptional quality of our professionally qualified and experienced teachers. Each and every teacher is selected through a rigorous recruitment process. On joining our pre-school & child care facility

teachers undergo extensive training designed jointly with the EtonHouse academic team. This is followed by regular trainings on a variety of subjects throughout the school year.

The teacher, like the parents and children, also has rights within this unique system. It is the right of the teachers and workers of each school to contribute to the study and preparation of the conceptual models that

define educational content, objectives, and practices. Choices of methods, didactics, research and observation projects are discussed in an open forum with the pedagogical coordinators. The staff is a part of various teacher training sessions and general development intiatives while undertaking tasks of community management. Vivero teachers plan intentionally. They establish specific goals for their children,

as well as evaluate paths for inquiry based learning. They make decisions about learning experiences, resources, design and location of the learning environment, routines, group interactions and strategies for assessment. Our teachers are lifelong learners themselves. Continuously guided, coached and encouraged by a group of highly experienced school heads who meet on a regular basis to share and disseminate best practices across our schools.



## ENVIRONMENT The Third Teacher

At Vivero, we aim to develop engaging environments that support children's curiosity and wonder, while providing safe ways for them to explore their world and stimulate their minds. The surroundings of the pre-school and child care facility are a place of shared relationships among the children, the teachers and the parents. The facility produces a feeling of belonging in a world that is alive, welcoming and authentic.

The layout of the physical space encourages encounters, communication and relationships. The arrangement of structures, objects and activities encourages choices, problem solving and discoveries in the process of learning.

#### Internal Environment

We reinforce a child's sense of belonging. We ensure that our Reggio-inspired

classroom environment is beautiful, soothing, full of wonder and discovery, so that children feel intrigued, respected, and eager to spend their days learning in it.

Display boards adorned with pictures of child's family and creations, gives him/her a sense of security and acceptance.

Intelligently designed learning spaces, with an array of natural material, develop a child's creative and cognitive capacity, while allowing a child, the space to be on his/her own, to study or reflect. Ergonomically designed child friendly furniture, remove restrictions on movement,

and allows for flexible learning spaces.

#### EXTERNAL ENVIRONMENT

We provide children with ample opportunity to engage with nature in a clean and safe way. We utilise the external environment and its various open-ended resources like leaves, twigs etc. to aid a child's physical, social, emotional and cognitive development. With spacious outdoor facilities like water play area, sand play area, jungle gym, traffic parks and much more, Vivero infuses the best of what the outdoors have to offer, through a holistically driven educational approach.

# HEALTH AND SAFETY

Vivero provides children with much more than a safe and secure environment. Here each child feels comfortable to explore, discover, challenge and understand their physical worlds, without fear. To us, a child's health and safety is of prime importance. Safety policy for our pre-school and child care facilities include the following:

- Hand sanitization and a temperature check for children as they enter school every day
- Demarcation of spaces with safety gates, nets and railings wherever required
- Careful selection of developmentally appropriate toys and learning tools
- Regular quality check of materials and manufacturing
- Regular sanitization of all materials handled by children
- Training of teachers and staff in basic first aid
- Mandatory fire drills conducted with children on a regular basis
- Security personnel to monitor all children, parents and visitors at the school
- CCTV add to the safety aspects of the school
- Police verification and annual medical test of the support staff
- Service evaluations at regular intervals
- Picket fences at strategic locations
- Fresh meals prepared in consultation with a nutritionist





# THE GLOBAL CITIZEN

We live in a complex and evolving world: a world without geographic boundaries, a world of great environmental change, a world of haves and have nots and a world where change is the only constant. It is imperative that global citizens of tomorrow come equipped with the evolved mindsets, knowledge and skills, to flourish in such an environment. 
### PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAMME

Our pre-school programme enhances a child's innate curiosity and provides a rich and carefully resourced environment to stimulate learning and development in children.

To ensure all-round development, we focus on six areas of learning:

- Personal, Social and Emotional
- Physical
- Creative
- Knowledge and Understanding of the World
- Problem Solving, Reasoning and Numeracy
- Communication, Language and Literacy

We know children learn best through questioning, exploring and implementing. Our Inquiry cycle empowers children to explore their abilities to their full potential. Learning is constructed in a way that is specific to the needs of each learner within the classroom.





### CHILD CARE PROGRAMME

Our Child Care programme is much more than just a drop-off location for working parents. It forms the foundation for holistic child development and gives children ample opportunities to engage in a range of educational and social activities in a safe, secure and hygienic environment. Parents are always assured in the knowledge that our curriculum uses a unique approach to promote the emotional, intellectual, physical and social development of children. Our high quality child care has a positive influence not only on children's development and school readiness but also on the parents' emotional well-being.

#### Infant Care Programme

The infant starts his/her learning journey with us in an environment that facilitates the development of their minds and bodies. Our programme is designed in a way so as to engage the child's five senses in order to promote the natural instincts of curiosity and discovery.

#### Toddler Care Programme

When a child is pushing boundaries, they're discovering their world. The activities for this age group are built around a toddlers' limitless curiosity and their natural desire to push boundaries. Our programme channels their exploding energy and satisfies their ever-growing curiosity.

#### Pre-schooler Care Programme

The program provides a safe, nurturing, and stimulating environment where learning flourishes. It reflects an understanding that children learn through active involvement and play while demonstrating & representing their knowledge in a variety of ways. It utilizes developmentally appropriate materials and practices that enhance the child's social, emotional, physical and intellectual development.

#### After school Care Programme

At Vivero, we recognize the growing physical intellectual and social competence of the increasingly independent school-age child. Eager to a social and academic understanding while expanding their knowledge of the world, our program perfectly blends learning opportunities in a fun environment for maturing school-age children. We offer children, time to wonder, explore, touch, sense and solve in many different ways.



### NURTURING GLOBAL CITIZENS

In line with our purpose we strive to create learning experiences and environments that not only support emerging skills in reading, math and science, but also the 21st century skills such as critical thinking, collaboration, communication, creativity, tech literacy, and social-emotional development. To foster these skills we have integrated a few of the following initiatives into our curriculum:

- Elementary Coding: *Vivero Junior Pro* is integrated into our pre-school programme such that our children not just learn and use languages to instruct the computer but alongside learn life skills
- Entrepreneurship Programme: Activities are interwoven into the curriculum to help build the foundation of essential entrepreneurial skills that will help children lead successful, fulfilling lives
- Digital Citizenship: This programme enables children to use digital media in safe, responsible and effective ways by ingraining DQ (Digital Quotient) skills
- Civic Management: Our teachers facilitate projects & engagements where children learn to become civil members of the community and understand their roles and responsibilities
- Culinary Programme: *Vivero Culinary practice* focuses on developing essential life skills while enhancing science, math, comprehension and fine motor skills
- Student Led Conferences: In the student-led conference format, children and teachers prepare together and then children lead the conference while teachers facilitate

### Our Quality Standards

Equipped with a great program that is powered by an equally great leadership team, Vivero stands a clear head above others in providing a rich and diverse learning environment for young children. We stand true to our promise of excellence across all operations including Curriculum, Safety, Security, and Cleanliness & Hygiene. Clear systems and processes assist facilitators and supports staff teams to continuously monitor service and training quality and look for constant improvement. Each quality control process governs our actions from the moment a child walks through the gate, at study or play or meal time, until the moment the child is safely back home. Often, the quality process continues to govern the adults at home, in their interactions with their child.

A 360-degree check is maintained by collecting objective feedback from all stakeholders. Keeping to the open door policy, a confidential bi-annual feedback is collected from parents and teachers. This is further analyzed and synthesized by the back end team to support improvement of the product. A daily quality check is conducted and shared with the Head - Quality Assurance. They aid effectiveness and eliminate inefficiency by ensuring all aspects of operations are run optimally. A 'Quality Audit' taken every trimester marks a blanket seal of excellence to the Pre-schools.



























