GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR NEW ADMISSION FOR THE SESSION 2018-19

- 1. Admissions are open for the classes I to VIII and a selected few in class IX, X if seats fall vacant.
- Prospectus and admission forms can be obtained from the Vidalia's office on payment of Rs.500/-only.
- Registration Forms for these classes are available / and will be accepted FROM the month of December.

The following documents are required at the time submission of registration form: -

- Application form for Registration.
- Photo copy of the previous class annual Progress Report/ Mark Statement of the school
 of First semester where the child is studying at present.
- Medical History of the child to be given by the parent.

- 4. Selected candidates will be informed telephonically to report for the Entrance Test. They must report to the school at 09.00 a.m sharp. Registration cum entrance test fee of Rs.4000/-only should be paid in the office of the Vidyalaya before the child appears for the entrance test.
- 5. The children seeking admission must have to appear for written tests as under:

CLASS	SUBJECTS	MAX.MARKS	TIME
IV to VII	English, Hindi, Mathematics	50 each paper	1 hr.
VIII TO IX	English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science & Social science	50 each paper	1 hr.

6. Syllabus for the admission test for various classes is as under:

FOR CLASS I TO III

Prescribed NCERT text books of previous class of English, Hindi and Mathematics.

FOR CLASS IV

Prescribed NCERT text books of class 3rd of English, Hindi and Mathematics.

FOR CLASS V

Prescribed NCERT text books of class 4th of English, Hindi and Mathematics.

FOR CLASS VI

Prescribed NCERT text books of class 5th of English, Hindi and Mathematics.

FOR CLASS VII

Prescribed NCERT text books of class 6th of English, Hindi and Mathematics.

FOR CLASS VIII & IX

Prescribed NCERT text books of class 8th and 9th of English, Hindi and Mathematics.

- 7. Parents are requested to collect lunch coupons from the PRO office for having lunch in the school mess on the day of the test.
- 8. Results would be intimate telephonically or declared on the same day.
- 9. Parents are requested to pay the school fees as mentioned in the Fee Structure within 7 days to secure the seat for their wards, failing which, it will be allotted to the next candidate on the list.
- 10. Joining instruction will be sent to the concerned parents so as to enable them to make necessary preparations.
- 11. The newly admitted children are expected to report to the school by 10.00 hrs. on the day of reporting and parents are requested to collect the school/annual calendar.
- 12. Since the standard of Hindi is very high as compared to S.S.C Board, parents are requested to engage Hindi teachers during summer vacation to cover the syllabus so that their child is able to cope up with the normal class when he joins the schools. This would give him a good start.
