






also at times provide a much-needed break from academics.

MOTHER'S LOVE LIBERATES






EK NAAM - TEEN AYAAM THE A.R.T SUMMER WORKSHOP



INTRODUCTION OF MASTERY ASSESSMENT IN CLASSES III TO V

Mastery Assessment success in Middle school in the last session has led to introduction of the same in the Primary Wing. To increase conceptual clarity and promote out of the box critical and creative thinking amongst the students in Mathematics and Science, a systematic change in the curriculum delivery has been incorporated in the Academic Calendar. We are systematically moving them away from rote learning to competency based teaching and learning.

The School has embedded a competency based education approach in Pedagogy and Assessment. Our Mastery Assessment is based on teach, test, re-teach, retest concept, followed by a detailed result analysis done by the teachers to identify the learning gaps in students. Growth and performance of every child is studied and tracked for individualised learning plan.

MATHEMATICS & SCIENCE BENCHMARKING

Across the school, Benchmarking Test is conducted to identify gifted students who display aptitude for Science and Mathematics and exhibit a positive learning temperament. The test is conducted by Maths and Science departments individually.

Enrichment & Focus Classes for children who require additional support.

INTRODUCTION OF LIFE SKILL WORKSHOPS

The school regularly organises life skill workshops for the students on practical problems that students face in their day to day life. The aim of Counselling is to enable the learners to make their own choices, reach their own decisions and act upon them mindfully.
