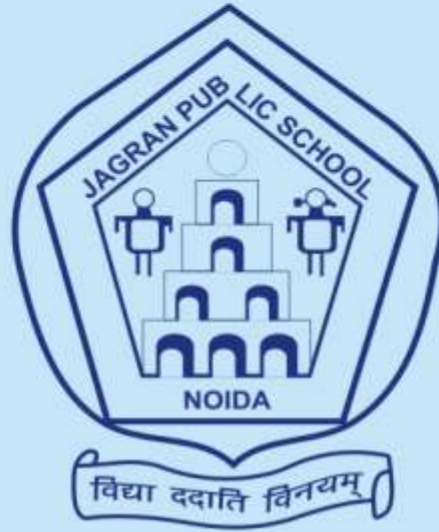

Within a short span of time, the school has attained a prominent place among the top Schools of Noida. Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi has granted affiliation to the school as an English medium Co-educational Senior Secondary School (Affiliation No.2130978) in 2006.

It has been registered under the Societies Registration Act (XXI) of 1860. Staff

The staff consists of qualified teachers with relevant experience of teaching in recognized English medium schools. It is our endeavour to regularly train our teachers in the latest developments in the field of educational technology. The school arranges workshops and seminars for the teachers in different subjects.



Curriculum

The school curriculum is divided into Pre-Primary, Primary, Middle, Secondary and Senior Secondary levels. At all levels, we follow a balanced curriculum which is based on the best practices across the country and guided by NCERT and CBSE regulations.

Pre-Primary School

Education is not just a necessity, it has become a reason to exist. The Pre-Primary Wing of our school provides the tiny-tots a learning environment that takes care of their physical, mental, emotional and intellectual development with love and care. We make each child's first step in schooling a journey where fun and learning, traditions and trends go hand in hand and our affectionate and caring teachers hold the child's hand through the first step of learning.

Instead of rote-learning, our teaching is through self learning process by way of quizzes, indoor and outdoor games, story sessions, audio-visual aids, art & craft and music activities to work towards intellectual growth and development of gross and fine motor skills. During Two years of Pre-Primary school, children learn the alphabet and their sounds, formation of simple two and three letter words in English and Hindi. Enough practice is given to them to know the phonetic sounds of the alphabet, nursery rhymes, numbers and finally good manners.

Primary School (Class 1 to 4)

At this vibrant age when the students are active and eager to learn, they are guided by competent and trained teachers to lay the firm foundation for a glowing future. Main subjects which are taught in classes 1 to 4 are: English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Science, Computer Studies, GK/Value Education/Life Skills, Art & Craft, Music and Games. French is introduced as an additional language from class three.

Middle School

This is the stage to fine tune the growing minds to tread on the right path in their lives. We ensure that the students





experience a smooth transition into their very important and formative teens through equal measure of class room studies, learning resources and outdoor activities. Main subjects which are taught in classes V to VIII are: English, Hindi, Mathematics, Social Studies, Computer Studies, GK/Value Education/Life Skill, Art, Craft, Music and Games. French/Sanskrit is taught as a third language from Class V to VIII as per CBSE regulations.

Senior School

As the world of cut throat competition beckons, the versatility is brought to the forefront not just through class-room teaching, but by integrating interactive educational classes, general studies and career counselling with the regular curriculum. This ensures that the students choose a proper future path as they step into the vast world outside, after fruitful years at Jagran Public School. Main subjects of study in classes IX and X : English Communicative, Hindi Course A/Sanskrit/French, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, and Foundation of Information Technology as an additional optional subject. The admission and choice of subjects in Class XI is done strictly according to Merit, based on the performance of the students at the Class X. The school offers the following combination of subjects in Class eleven :

1. Science Stream (with Mathematics): English Core, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science, Physical Education.
2. Science Stream (with Biology): English Core, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Physical Education.
3. Commerce Stream : English Core, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Mathematics/Informatics Practices/Painting, Physical Education.
4. Humanities Stream : English Core, History/Political Science/Sociology, Geography/ Psychology, Economics, Mathematics /Informatics Practices, Physical Education.
(Humanities Stream is available depending the number of students opting for it.)



ABOUT US

The National Capital Region, Noida has emerged as a very well planned modern city with convenient road connectivity to all the prominent centres of urban and rural habitation. Jagran Public School is a landmark for Sector 47 and other adjoining areas. It is linked with City Centre, Atta (The Great India Place), Ashok Nagar (New Delhi), Greater Noida, Indirapuram etc. within a driving distance between 3 to 10 km.

The school is situated over a prime land in Block D of Sector 47. It Covers an area of 5 acres. The three storeyed magnificent School Building is truly "owner's pride and neighbour's envy." . The ambience around the school is peaceful and completely pollution free. The ever green sports field in front of the school building, beautifully designed gardens near the entrance gate, the volleyball and basketball courts with a row of Jamun trees add glory to the school building.

Curriculum

Jagran Public School, Noida, a co-educational English medium school affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi for 10+2 stage of Education in Science & Commerce streams. Courses of Study

Life Skills and Value Education

Life Skills are defined as "The abilities that help learners to be successful in living a productive life. They help the students to improve their personal and social qualities." Along with the teaching of Life Skills, we strive to develop and inculcate universal human values in our students. Ancient Indian culture and traditions, teachings of different religious faiths are the guiding principles of Value Education in our school. We lay special emphasis on building strong moral conduct and character.

Sanskrit and French

The students can choose Sanskrit or French as a third language in Classes V to VIII. Elementary French is introduced in Classes III & IV. We also offer a choice for the second language (Hindi/Sanskrit/French) in classes 9 and 10.

Student - Parent - Teacher Interaction

The school urges parents to keep constant communication to help monitor the growth and development of the student. Parent teacher meetings are held about four times a year so that the parents can discuss their wards progress with the subject teachers. Along with this, the Class Teachers, the Coordinators and in-charges of the Nursery, Primary, Middle and Senior sections apart from the Vice Principal are available for interaction with the parents. Parents are encouraged to discuss their wards education and well being with the Principal at the appointed time.



Parents Teacher Session (LKG / UKG)

School has introduced Parent Teacher Session instead of routine Parent Teacher Meeting for the parents of pre primary classes. The PTS is organised on the last saturday of the month during which teachers share the teaching methodology and content / syllabi of the concerned class.

Spic Macay

Music & Dance concerts of a number of artists of International repute in various fields viz. Dance, skit, talk etc. will be organized in collaboration with Spic Macay, Delhi.

Safety Programmme

We are pleased to inform you that the school as its responsibility towards the safety of children is implementing project CACA - Children against Child Abuse www.projectcaca.org from the academic year 2018-19 onwards. Project CACA is the need of the hour.

Students' Quality Circle

The Quality Circle Academy has been set up in our school in the month of August' 2017. The Quality Circle has been named as "Shri Puran Chandra Academy of Quality Circle". This will help students for solving their problems in many ways by using the techniques & skills. Few of these are as under :

Robotic Education

Jagran Public School, Noida has set-up a state-of-Art Robotic Education in its school premises in collaboration with FIZ Robotic solutions (FRS) & Terra Drones (Australia) in October' 2017 for Classes V to X under 'Work Performance Activities'. FRS also has set-up a well established State-of-Art Robotic lab in school premises.



Art & Music Education

The Art Education covers the following areas :

- Visual Arts : Drawing, Painting, Tie and Dye, Batik and Block Printing etc.
- Performing Arts : Music (Vocal & Instrumental), Dance (Indian Classical and Folk), Public speaking (Elocution, Declamation, Debate, Group Discussion), Dramatics etc.

The vigorous music Syllabus in our School is a source of inspiration to us. We start laying the foundation right from the Pre-Primary stage. The Shankar Mahadevan Online Interactive Music Curriculum is followed in LKG and UKG and taken further up to Class IV. It is here that through individual and group singing accompanied by various musical Instruments, the children pick up the true concept of Swar and Taal. Our Music Department possesses a whole range of Indian and Western Musical Instruments.



Computer Science Education

Computer Science is taught in our school as a compulsory time-tabled subject from Class I onwards. A student may offer Computer Science or Informatics Practices as an Elective Subject in Class XI/XII. Every Student necessarily gets a "hands-on" training. Students of Class Nine and ten study Foundation of Information Technology as an additional optional subject. There are three independent Computer Science laboratories for Primary, Middle and Senior school Students.

Science Laboratories

The school has fully developed laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics besides a General Science Laboratory for the Middle School Children. All Labs are well lighted and ventilated and fully equipped with the necessary equipments and chemicals etc. We have plans to establish Geography and Home Science Labs also. A small work station for Robotics has been created in the Physics Lab.





Smart Class Rooms

Teaching and Learning is no longer boring after the installation of ten smart class rooms. All students and teachers have direct access to these digital class rooms with interactive smart boards. We continue to use other teaching aids as well, for example, TV, LCD, Projector and Audio Visual Projector etc.

Medical Inspection Room

The Nursing Sister keeps a health record of all the students. Class Teachers inform the Parents about height & weight and any other ailment of the student at the end of each term. During the school hours, if any student or member of the staff falls sick or suffers due to the injury, then the FIRST AID is provided to him/her immediately. In case of any serious illness or injury the patient is referred to a nearby hospital. Periodical Medical Check-up of the students is also carried out by Visiting doctors.

Canteen

Our School Canteen provides healthy and nutritious snacks and food items to the students and staff at very reasonable rates. The students are allowed to visit the canteen during the recess only or after the school gets over. The rates and quality of the food items are checked regularly by the school staff.

Library and Learning resource centre

The Central Library which is situated on the first floor caters to the needs of the staff and students of senior school. The Learning Resource Centre (LRC) is meant for all the Junior students. The Central Library and the LRC have been enriched with a huge collection of books, magazines and periodicals, newspapers, educational DVDs and CDs etc. Students are also encouraged to subscribe for a personal copy of the student's edition of newspaper like Times of India – Newspaper in Education and Hindustan Times – PACE.





House Culture

The Students are divided into four houses called Blue Birds, Green Leaves, Golden Wings and Red Roses. This division provides opportunities for more intimate organization and for a healthy rivalry in sports and other activities between the houses. Each house is under the charge of a house mentor, who is responsible for grooming the students with the help of other house teachers and house perfects. The System encourages a sense of team work and community responsibility.

Literary Activities

Students take part in activities like Recitation, Elocution Story Telling, Declamation, Debate, Group Discussion, Dramatics, and Public Speaking, News Reading etc. From time to time children are guided and trained by their house mentors to hone their skills in these literary activities. Students are selected to show case their talent on special occasions like Hindi Week, Sanskrit Week, French Week, and special Assemblies and other school functions.

Work Experience

'I Read, I forget; I write, I remember; I do, I learn' Learning by doing is an age old principle. There are more than two dozen age-appropriate activities out of which the children can choose one or two activities during each term/semester, Origami, Needle – work, Candle Craft, Drawing, Painting, Tie and Dye, Music (Vocal, Instrument, Dance), Robotics etc. are a few prominent work experience activities which children pursue every week throughout the academic year .

Scouts and Girl Guides

Boys and Girls belonging to Classes V to VIII are encouraged to join Bharat Scouts and Guides. Vivekanand Troop for Boys Scouts and Rani Laxmi Bai Troop for the girl Guides have been registered with Bharat Scouts and Guides, Noida. These Children get regular training by our teachers and also attend Endurance and Training Camps organized in the school.

Admission Procedure

For admission to LKG the child should be 3 years plus on the 1st of April of the year of admission. The children are admitted into LKG and UKG after a very brief interaction with the prospective child and parents. Parents / Guardians Seeking admission for their wards in any Class have to fulfil the necessary conditions as per the School rules.

- A. The School will register names for admission by filling in the Registration forms. The Prospectus and the registration forms are available at the School counter.
- B. The Registered applicants will be tested on the basis of standard NCERT Syllabus through a written test on a particular date which will be notified to the parents .
- C. The candidates shortlisted on the basis of written test, may be called for an interview and final list of the selected students will be displayed on the school notice board in the month of March every year.
- D. Selected students will be admitted within a week after the publication of the results.
- E. All students have to submit the following documents at the time of paying the fees
 1. Pass Certificate from the previous school.
 2. Valid Proof of Age / Transfer Certificate from the Previous School.
 3. The Character Certificate (For Students of Class VIII and Above)



Withdrawal Rules

A parent wishing to withdraw his ward must give at least one month's notice in writing. The Transfer Certificate and the Progress Report Card will not be issued until School dues are cleared. In case of withdrawal of the student by the parent, no request for refund of the annual Charges / Tuition Fees / Transport Fees will be considered.

School Timings

School timings remain the same throughout the year. In case of any change in the timings, it is notified through a circular to the parents.
