◆ PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES CAREFULLY TO AVOID THE REJECTION OF YOUR FORM.

1. **Eligibility Criteria of age:** **Nursery:** 3+ as on 31st March 2021, **LKG:** 4+ as on 31st March 2021, **UKG:** 5+ as on 31st March 2021, **CLASS I:** 6+ as on 31st March 2021.
2. **For Nursery:** Children born between **01-04-2017 and 31-03-2018**(No Compromise on age criteria.)
3. Forms will not be available from the school. You can register online through our website www.delhimarthomaschoolgzb.org and once your registration is received by DMPS Ghaziabad, School Admission Office will get in touch with you for further processing of your application.
4. The Registration Form may flicker to refresh while it retrieves dynamic data from our database. Please **DO NOT** enter or select any data till refreshing is completed, as it may lead to loss of entered or selected data.
5. **Do not** press the **ENTER** key to move from one field to another. Use the **TAB** key or the mouse for the same.
6. To avoid rejection, **DO NOT SUBMIT** more than one Form for one applicant
7. All fields are mandatory. The application form will be rejected if the information given is incomplete or found to be not true or if the required documents are missing.
8. Please enter your contact number and email Id correctly, as the same will be used for further communication.
9. All the entries are made carefully as any request for change will NOT be entertained.
10. The Registration process may take more time if you have a slow or poor internet connection.
11. Admission will be considered based on the availability of seats.
12. The students will be admitted purely on the basis of entrance test and interview.
13. There will not be written test for Nursery
14. No external interference will be entertained regarding the admission procedure.
15. No fee will be refunded if cancellation is made after admission.

3. SC/ST/OBC Certificate (if applicable)
4. Combined Post card size Family photograph. (Max 500Kb)
