Mother Teresa was a moving image of compassion, goodness and godliness. As an apostle of love, hope and mercy, she had been the mother in the truest sense to the millions and millions of destitute, deprived and dying in India. She was awarded Nobel Peace Prize in 1979 for her outstanding services to humanity, and Bharat Ratna in 1980. She was born in Macedonia to Albanian parents in 1910, but chose India for her missionary activities. She later became an Indian citizen. She founded schools, hospitals, dispensaries, shelters and homes for the destitute, aged lepers, dying and the neglected. She founded the Missionaries of Charity to serve the suffering humanity. She passed away at the age of the 87 on September 5, 1997 in Kolkata, causing a tragic and irreparable loss to the entire world. The death of this saint of mercy, plunged millions of people into extreme grief and sorrow across the globe.

Here below is given an address delivered by her at the National Prayer Breakfast sponsored by the US Senate and House of Representatives.

We must remember that love begins at home and we must remember that 'the future of humanity passes through the family.' Our children depend on us for everything - their health, their nutrition, their security, their coming to know and love God. For all of this, they look to us with trust, hope and expectations.

We are talking of love of the child, which is where love and peace must begin. The child is God's gift to the family. Each child is created in the special images and likeness of God for greater things - to love and to be loved.

"It is not how much we do, but how much love we put into what we do. We are all one heart full of love, that we may bring that joy of love everywhere we go. And my prayer for you is that through this love for one another, for this peace and joy in the family, that you may grow in holiness. Holiness is not the luxury of the few; it is simply duty, for you and for me, because Jesus has very clearly stated, "Be ye holy as my father in heaven is holy". So let us pray for each other that we grow in love for each other, and through this love become holy as Jesus wants us to be for he died out of love for us."



Pre Primary Section

Whole Pre Primary wing is air-conditioned and well-ventilated.

Smart Classes

We have smart classes in collaboration with Educomp which help students to clear the concepts. Audio Visual Room is equipped with LCD project where Pre Primary children learn rhymes, other concepts and watch animated cartoons through interactive CD s etc. At primary & secondary levels students learn through power point presentation and various educational CDs.

English Language Lab

In the "English Savvy Era" our lab will enhance the children's vocabulary, improve pronunciation, articulation and fluency through digital audio-visual aids.

Our lab is equipped with all the modern facilities to groom the children for better communication to become global citizens.

Math Lab

Mathematics is a subject which is very closely associated with life's day to day activities.

To clear the concepts & make the subject interesting we have set mathematics lab. Students perform activities under the supervision of proficient teachers.



School Library

The school maintains well stocked library with the collection of story books, reference books on every subject, illustrated dictionaries, encyclopedias, magazines and newspapers. Library is constantly enriched by the latest editions and new arrivals. Students are encouraged to use the library to enhance reading habits.

Auditorium

Well equipped with the latest audio- visual facilities and seating capacity of around 400, the centrally air-conditioned Auditorium hosts a variety of cultural events to provide a platform for showcasing the talent of our students.



Science Lab

Mid-day Meal For Pre- Primary Children

The school has set up a state-of-the-art canteen with the vendor being one of the most reputed ones. The canteen is carefully maintained for complete hygiene and is regularly monitored by a steering committee.



Academics

PRE PRIMARY WING - The approach at Pre Primary is 'Child Centered'. "Play While Learn and Learn While Play" is the main objective at this level. Emphasis is given on imparting knowledge of the world around the child, developing linguistic & creative skills, fine & gross motor skills.

PRIMARY WING - The approach at this level is 'Learning by Doing'. A thematic approach is followed to stimulate children through interactive sessions, projects, surveys and other innovative activities. Emphasis on participation of each student in the curricular & co-curricular activities is given along with the strong sense of individuality.

SENIOR WING - It follows an enriched curriculum with in-depth knowledge of the subjects. Presentations, surveys, research work are given the utmost importance. Besides following the NCERT guidelines, the school keeps an open mind to the changing educational patterns. Admission Procedure

Registration does not guarantee admission. From K.G. onwards every candidate will be required to appear for an admission test. It is the responsibility of the parent's /guardian to bring the candidate to the school for the test on the date & time fixed by the school, failing which no admission test/interview will be re-conducted.

Rules of withdrawals

In case of a withdrawal of a child from the school, the school-leaving certificate will be issued only after the clearance from accounts. No student will be permitted for the withdrawal after the commencement of the session i.e. after 1st April unless fee up to the summer vacation is paid. No student's name will be withdrawn unless one month prior notice is given or one month tuition fee is paid in lieu of the Notice. Payment of fee, at the time of withdrawal shall be accepted in cash only.

- * Admission is granted purely on the basis of merit irrespective of caste, creed or community.
- * Every candidate must be registered with the school prior to appearing for the admission test.
- * For registration, the parent / guardian should obtain the prospectus-cum-application form on payment from the school office. It should be submitted to the school office within the specified time.
- * Documents required at the time of registration are. 1) two photographs of the child 2) photo each of Father and Mother 3) Date of Birth Certificate from Municipal Office 4) proof of residence 5) Mark sheet of the previous class passed (from class 1 onwards) 6) Transfer Certificate.
- * On the basis of the test and personal interview students will be selected for admission. parent / guardian will be required to deposit the fee within three days of the issue admission order. Failing that, the seat will be treated as vacant and will be offered to the next candidate at the discretion of the Principal. Admissions are made on a full year basis and the parent guardian is required to pay the fees for the entire year.
- * At the time of admission student migrating from other school, should get a transfer certificate countersigned by the District Education Officer and a mark sheet from the school last attended, failing which admission will be cancelled.
- * Registration for admission test is valid for one admission test only. Registration fee is not refundable. Parents should read the terms and conditions, age requirement and other conditions carefully before registering the child.

Evaluation System / Promotion

Continuous and comprehensive evaluation is done regularly in the form of unit tests, terms and annual exams. Class teacher keeps up-to-date records of all the students. Periodical progress reports about scholastic achievements, participation in co-curricular activities, interest shown in out-door activities by the students are regularly intimated to guardians through PTMs.

Promotion is granted on the basis of whole year assessment of the pupil. In addition to Annual and Terminal examinations, a complete record of daily work and weekly tests is maintained. No request for re-test will be entertained.

School Fee

- * Fee and other dues are received from 1st to 20th of every quarter, i.e. April, July, October and January.
- * Fee will be payable by cheque at school.
- * Fee will be received from 8.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. only.
- * Fee and other dues are to be paid for full academic year including conveyance charges.
- * In the following cases, students will be re-admitted only on payment of re-admission fee at the discretion of the Principal
 - * a) If the child is withdrawn willingly by the parents.
 - * b) If the name is struck-off as disciplinary measures.
 - * c) On account of long absence or non-payment of school dues in the same month.
- * No student will be allowed to sit in weekly unit test, Terminal as well as Annual Examination if the dues are not cleared.
- * Fee paid receipts must be produced whenever required by the school authorities.
- * Non-production of receipts will be treated as non-payment of dues.
- * Examinations fee will be charged extra. Dues once paid are not refundable in any case.
- * Rs. 20 as fine per day will be charged if the fee is not deposited before 20th of the month which it falls due.
- * No deletion/alteration of any amount is permissible.
- * After 25th, the name of the ward will be struck off the rolls without informing in writing.
- * Fee and other charges once paid is not refundable.
- * Re-admission shall be allowed only after payment of re-admission-fee, fine and other dues etc.

Rules & Regulations




1. All the students should come in neat & clean dress.
2. Students must reach the school at least ten minutes before the morning assembly.
3. In case of absence, application for leave should be given. Only those applications for leave are considered genuine which are duly signed by parent/guardian.
4. Any damage done in the school premises will have to be rectified by the parents.
5. Parents and guardians are not allowed to meet their children or teachers during study-hours.
6. The students must take part in all extra curricular activities of the school assigned to them. Parents' co-operation is required in this regard.
7. The parents are requested to co-operate in the academic matter by enforcing regularity, discipline and taking general interest in the progress of their ward.
8. If the child or his parent misbehaves with any member of the staff, the school has every right to take action against him/her.
9. No student is allowed to leave the school-premises during the school hours. They are forbidden to purchase anything from outside.
10. Discipline and decent behaviour are given the highest importance. Every student is expected to obey the teachers and follow all the rules and regulations.
11. Use of the profane language or immoral behaviour will be considered serious offence and the punishment can amount to the student's expulsion from the school.
12. In case of long leaves on medical grounds a medical certificate must be attached with the application.
13. Students suffering from any contagious or infectious disease must complete the quarantine period before re-joining the school. This should be indicated on the medical certificate duly signed by medical practitioner.
14. Children are not allowed to keep money with them except the nominal pocket money.
15. Parents are usually allowed to meet the teachers only on parent -teacher meeting days. They may meet the Principal; from 9:00 am to 10:00am with prior appointment.
16. No valuable articles should be brought by the students. Money should neither be lent nor borrowed or articles exchanged.
17. The school does not hold any responsibility, legal or otherwise for unforeseen accidents in the school or while travelling in the school buses and on tours. The school will however, take all necessary steps to prevent such happenings.
