# Compassion. Resilience. Awareness.

At Khaitan Public School we have partnered with an innovative K-12 education programme called SEE (Social, Emotional, and Ethical) Learning. SEE Learning is the vision of His Holiness the Dalai Lama and is developed by Emory University USA. It is a comprehensive framework for cultivating social, emotional and ethical competencies which has a comprehensive focus on ethics. Ethics, here, are not based on any particular culture or religion, but rather grounded in universal, basic human values such as compassion, tolerance and forgiveness.

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### What is it?

SEE Learning provides educators with the tools they need to foster the development of emotional, social, and ethical intelligence for students and themselves. It represents the state of the art in education by enhancing SEL programming with key additional components, including:

attention training

compassion and ethical discernment

systems thinking

resilience and trauma-informed practice

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### Who benefits from it?

It has traditionally been assumed that academic and social emotional issues are distinct, and anything that doesn't directly relate to students' academic performance must be dealt with outside the classroom. However, research—along with the personal experience of many students and teachers—has indicated that working through social/emotional issues productively has very positive outcomes like better academic performance, fewer disciplinary incidents and greater awareness and understanding for students about how to handle their emotions. This programme provides educators with a developmentally-staged curriculum consisting of easy-to-implement lessons, the conceptual framework used to design the curriculum, and resources for educator preparation and development. SEE Learning empowers students to engage ethically as part of a global community and provides educators with the tools to support student wellbeing. SEE learning course is the science of compassion for the cultivation of awareness and is considered the future of education.

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### What are its benefits?

1. Offers a compassionate classroom environment in which students are treated fairly and respectfully by their teacher and other students, fostering a sense of belonging.
2. Encourages the development of mindful awareness that helps students regulate their bodies and provide themselves with self-care.
3. Fosters self-compassion and compassion for others which helps them build positive relationships with self and others.
4. Helps teach and practise attitudes and skills that allow students and educators to manage and recover from everyday stress and challenging situations. Educators can foster students' resilience by helping them to identify and create individual and social resources so that, when they are exposed to challenging events, they can access those resources.

We employ Artificial Intelligence (A.I.) for instant feedback, virtual classrooms and flipped learning, a blended learning approach that mixes personal interaction with independent study through technology. We have AI-enabled classrooms that simplify the creation, distribution and grading of academic material in a paperless way. Further, all academic data is streamlined on a dashboard, and the progress of the students monitored.

## The sports programmes across KPS

Khafan Physical Education Program (K-PEP) provides age appropriate and best practices that ensure our students experience and learn in a safe and supportive environment. KPS offers students a varied experience of multiple sports and physical activities.

At the re-primary and primary level, our focus is to develop the fundamental gross and fine motor skills, locomotor overments, and encourage cooperation through physical activities.

At the middle and high school level, we refine and develop their skills, introduce them to techniques and tactics, and encourage competitive sports.

The curricular outcomes help students understand that fitness, wellness, health dimensions, when woven together create an integrated and greater balance in one's life. We emphasize on the development of foundational skills, conceptual knowledge, the inculcation of social values and traits, and an understanding of the importance of a healthy lifestyle. We aim to develop our students in individual events, cooperation games, and team sports – invasion games to offer them a holistic development. Overall, we encourage our students to exhibit the spirit of sportsmanship, and carry over their learning from PE class to outside the physical activity settings. We have an afterschool sports academy as well.

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### The benefits to mental and physical wellbeing

There are immense benefits associated with social, emotional, mental, intellectual, and physical aspects to ensure overall wellness and holistic development. Our physical education program is a key contributor to help students develop positive behaviours that lead to more active and healthier lifestyles. Our PE program has age appropriate activities and we play a vital role in shaping our budding global citizens.



### Special features of sports at KPS

The PE program derives its standards from SHAPE America (Society for Health and Physical Education) and CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education). We provide equal opportunities to all students, and have an age appropriate developmental PE program that encompasses curriculum, instruction, and assessment for all our learners.

Every lesson has modifications for beginners, intermediates, advanced and special needs students. Within every unit, emphasis is placed on building collaborative skills to support students' interactions and flexibility with working in a variety of peer groups. Throughout the year, PE strives to improve an individual's overall wellness and foster the appreciation for fitness activities as a lifelong pursuit.





# Financial Literacy Programme @KPS



# You are never too young to learn about mortgages, credit cards and mutual funds. Because financial literacy is a crucial life skill.

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Today financial knowledge is a necessary life skill. However, a lot of people are not familiar with even the basic concepts of finance. This is the reason why Khaitan Public School introduced the Financial Literacy Programme for its students. The idea is to help them familiarize themselves with mortgages, loans, mutual funds, futures, credit cards, etc. Having picked up the skills early, children will understand how money works, and be fully prepared to make critical financial decisions, all through life.

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The concept of financial literacy is one of the most important needs of society. In the present socio-economic world, the school is the centre of holistic development, and this is why financial literacy is part of the school's integrated curriculum. In Financial Literacy Programme, we impart the basic knowledge of financial literacy, the banking system, budgeting household activities, understanding the need to save and plan, specific event expenditure without major financial burden and finally strengthening the economic stability in life. It also encourages children to start saving, early in life.

The Financial Literacy Programme has three different levels.

- 1 EARLY LEVEL: Grade-V, VI & VII
- 2 MIDDLE LEVEL: Grade-VIII & IX and finally
- 3 ADVANCED LEVEL: Grade X & XI

At each level, we engage our students with a researched curriculum through a hands-on learning approach, and follow the learning assessment at the end of the session with certification.

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At Khaitan Public School, we conduct the Numeracy Booster Programme which builds confidence in numeracy. Through this programme we intend to meet one of our key academic goals - improved standards of numeracy. It has been designed keeping in mind that children learn in different ways and at different rates. While some children find numeracy a breeze, for most children, learning mathematical skills takes much time, patience and practice. Our teachers have designed a comprehensive program which encompasses three numeracy interventions all of which are geared to meet the intended outcome of developing improved attitudes and confidence in numeracy.



The program has

with the following structure:

**NUMERACY SUPPORT:**

A comprehensive worksheet is given to the students every Friday. This worksheet covers all types of questions for the topic which the student has been learning during the week. It could be a practice worksheet from the Maths workbook as well.

**SELF-ASSESSMENT:**

Every first day of the week students are asked to self-check the worksheet given on the weekend and mark their questions. They will be asked to do the self-correction and clear their doubts if any.

**REMEDIATION:**

Every Saturday, a targeted remediation class is held for a selected group of students who require extra support and guidance. The uniqueness of it lies in supporting both less able and more able students.

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The establishment of a student council gives students an opportunity to acquire communication, planning and organisational skills which will benefit them in future. It enables students to take responsibility for projects, and demonstrate that they can lead and manage such projects. Moreover, the contribution made by a student council to the development of school policy in a number of areas can have significant benefits for students and the school. School policies are far more likely to be successful when they are clearly understood and accepted by all stakeholders within the school community.

The KPS council is called The Helm and leads the students in various events and projects throughout the year. Improving communication within the school community is a shared responsibility and a student council can contribute to this process – making presentations at staff meetings to keep the staff informed of activities, keeping the student body apprised about the activities conducted via the school newspaper, 'The Khaitan Dispatch'.

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# Placement Programme @KPS

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With career counselling and planning, we help each student in Grade XI & XII prepare a road map for future courses. The objective of this initiative is to promote the placement (admission to undergraduate programmes) of our students in India's top 50 universities and the world's top institutions and universities. We keep the target of at least 75% placement in top 50 Indian institutions/universities and 10% in top universities abroad, every year.

The merit of this initiative is to promote the culture of 'Result Driven Academic Journey with Focused Approach' in Senior Secondary Classes. Further, it is motivation for us to see the progress of our students through quality placement.

We encourage our students to expand their career choices beyond the conventional Engineering, Medical, Arts, etc to modern-day careers too.

Apart from Indian universities, they also get exposure to foreign universities for their undergraduate courses.

For career planning in Grades XI & XII, each student goes through various levels of assessment processes like psychometric analysis and career choice assessment.

After the interaction with the career counsellor, the student is connected directly to university representatives for finalising the career plan after school.

Throughout the session, each student gets an opportunity to connect and interact directly with the admission directors of prominent universities/institutions in India and abroad. We conduct the 'Global Career Fest' to enable the child to meet and discuss their admission related queries. From time to time, the school conducts a series of the sessions for various career related activities, and provides training for the preparation of SAT, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.

In the coming future, we are also planning to get an entry in the top 20 Ivy League universities of the world for admissions to various undergraduate programmes and prepare our students accordingly from early stages.

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With events like MUN and TEDx, we give our students a head start in the race to be the global citizens who lead the world.

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#### **MUN (Model United Nations)**

Preparing and participating in an MUN helps a student develop leadership, research, writing, public speaking, and problem-solving skills. Moreover, coming up with solutions that are acceptable to a majority of the representatives also inculcates skills of negotiation, conflict resolution, and cooperation.

It's a fun way to learn about the world, and in this era of globalization, being globally aware is more important than ever. Further, having fun makes learning easier and more memorable. MUN is also an exercise in research, public speaking, and teamwork. These are skills that students will need throughout their career, and MUN gives them a chance to practise them early in life.

They can also leverage the MUN experience and network to get into a college and even find jobs. Admissions officers and job interviewers look for examples of leadership, and their experiences as a delegate or conference organizer will stand in good stead. The event also helps them develop a network of alumni from their MUN club and the people they met at conferences.

The KhaitanMUN Global Thinkers' Conclave 2.0 to be held on the 19th and 20th of December, 2020 hosted over 400 delegates from Japan, Mexico, England, Saudi Arabia and all across the Indian subcontinent.

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### TEDx

The TED philosophy, according to Lara Stein, the Founder and Director of TEDx, consists of one sentence, "it's about simplified, authentic storytelling." This seems to fit well with its mission of "ideas worth spreading". Combine both with a remarkable TEDx organizer and speaker and you get an 18 minute presentation equivalent of a Hollywood blockbuster.

TED and TEDx are powerful events because their organizers and staff don't do it for the money or the fame. They do it to make a difference. And people that do things out of passion, do them better.

The difference between TED and TEDx events is that the former takes more of a global approach while the latter typically focuses on a local community that concentrates on local voices. (Officially, the 'x' in TEDx stands for independently organized TED event, but it's more of TED multiplied.)

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Learning through Internship Programme (LTI) is one of our planned multidimensional initiatives. The idea behind this initiative is to educate children about their career prospects, and shape the base for career development at an early stage in their life.

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Through this programme, our students:

During the internship: Meeting with the sponsored institutions/organisations in a real life scenario.

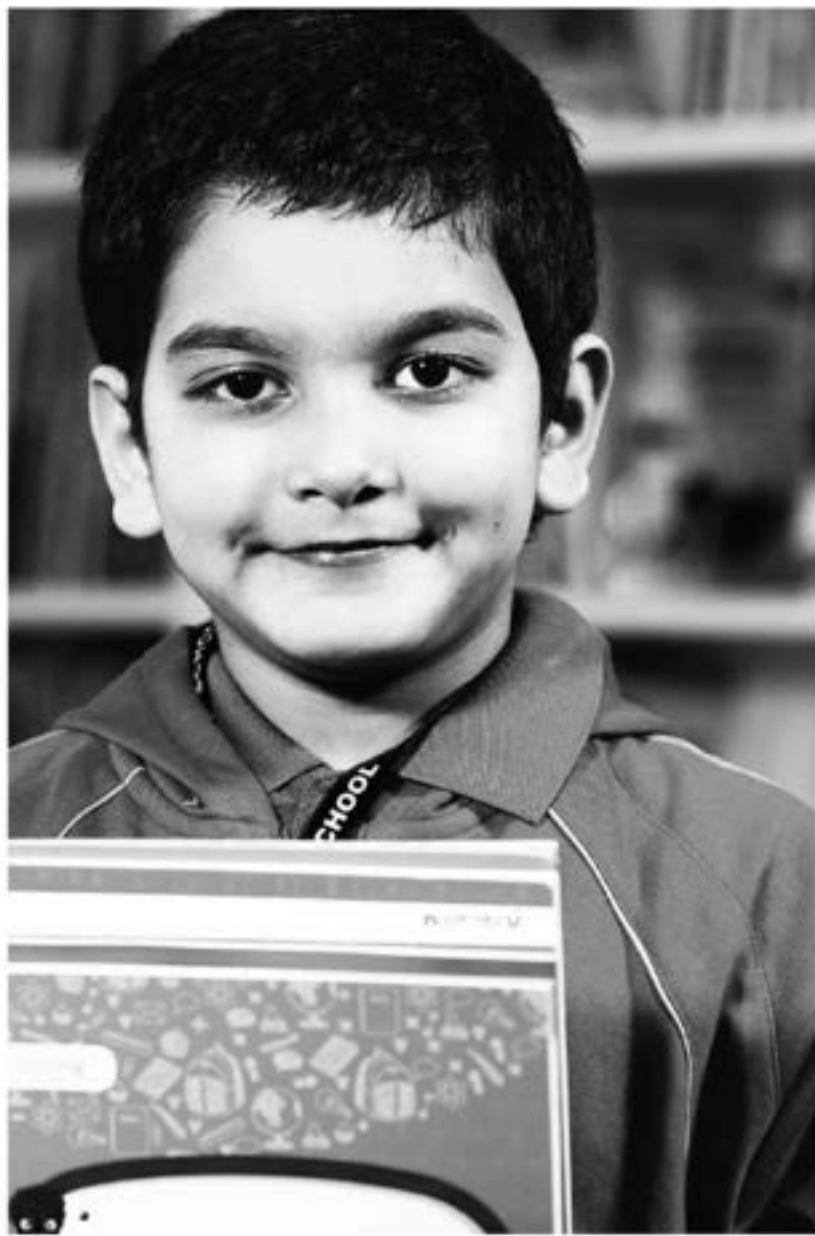
**Stage III:**

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# Literacy @KPS

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Literacy has traditionally been thought of as reading and writing. Although these are essential components of literacy, today our understanding of literacy encompasses much more. At KPS, literacy is the ability, confidence and willingness to engage with the language to acquire, construct and communicate meaning in all aspects of daily living. From the moment a child is born, his or her literacy journey begins. Children's literacy abilities are nurtured through their families and communities. As children enter the school system, there is a strong focus on the development of reading and writing skills. Children engage in learning opportunities that have them interacting with many different forms of text, in print and digital forms, using words, visuals and graphics. Students begin to learn the rules of language, how to acquire information, evaluate it, and ethically use it, how to construct meaning from various kinds of text and how to communicate effectively.

As students move through the school system, they continue to refine all of their foundational skills as they explore a wider variety of texts and technologies.

The vast amounts of information that are available through both print and the internet and the ability to communicate with wide and varied audiences around the globe have expanded the ways our students read and communicate. Literacy for our students today also means preparing themselves to be critical and ethical consumers of information.

#### What are its benefits?

1. Literacy promotes lifelong learning and builds skills
2. Literacy builds self esteem and overall quality of life
3. It prepares children to accept the world around them and make informed choices
4. It brings about awareness and makes students conscious about their contribution to society



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### Reading Programme at KPS

Reading Programme at KPS aims to activate and reinforce skills such as grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and writing by offering good writing models. It develops reading skills, which include: skimming, scanning, predicting, and reading for detailed comprehension. Our programme also provides opportunities to utilize and sharpen such skills as writing a business plan, make conclusions, draw comparisons, make inferences, etc. Most of all it is a programme to help students to discover the pleasure of being able to read in a second language and enjoy stories from around the world.

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#### The KPS Reading Programme has the following elements:

##### 1) Novel Study Programme (Grades IV-VIII):

This program entails five weeks of fiction and five weeks of nonfiction novel study for students from Grades IV to VIII.

##### Each child per grade uses the same book to:

- develop reading strategies and skills through five week intensive literature program, explicit teaching of annotation, thinking routines.
- writing about reading through art, sketchnoting, post-its, thinking routines and digital technology.
- develop understanding for both fiction and nonfiction text.
- provide close reading skills to students to help them navigate independent reading.

2) **Classroom Library Programme (Grade III):** Classroom Libraries for Grade III consists of 300 books. Each section receives a book basket of 60-70 books based on genres - fiction, nonfiction and further catering to subgenres for fiction and non-fiction. Classroom libraries promote independent purposeful reading. Brings readers closer to books and teachers and develops a school wide culture of reading.

3) **Read Aloud Programme (K-II):** The Read Aloud Programme entails a big book reading program to develop comprehension and thinking skills from Nursery to Grade II. We provide 30 big books along with 100 read aloud books to each grade to develop knowledge and awareness of themes through explicit teaching of reading strategies.
