

1. Do Indian universities recognize Cambridge qualifications?

Nearly all Indian universities with undergraduate programmes recognize Cambridge qualifications. Universities with formal recognition policies include central and state universities, as well as renowned private and deemed universities across the country. Indian higher education institutions recognize Cambridge International A Levels as equivalent to Indian senior secondary qualifications.

2. Will the Cambridge Primary and Cambridge Lower Secondary curricula run concurrently to the CBSE curriculum at school?

Yes, the Cambridge Primary and Cambridge Lower Secondary curricula will run concurrently to the CBSE curriculum at Seth Anandram Jaipuria School.

3. Since the school is delivering Cambridge Primary & Cambridge Lower Secondary for grade I to VIII, can a student join this Cambridge programme at, say, grade III or grade IV or grade V or grade VII or grade VIII? Or can a student join only at grade I?

A student can join the programme at any stage.

4. What's the cost differential between the CBSE Curriculum and Cambridge Curriculum?

There is a cost differential which can be discussed in a one-to-one interaction with the admission counselor.
