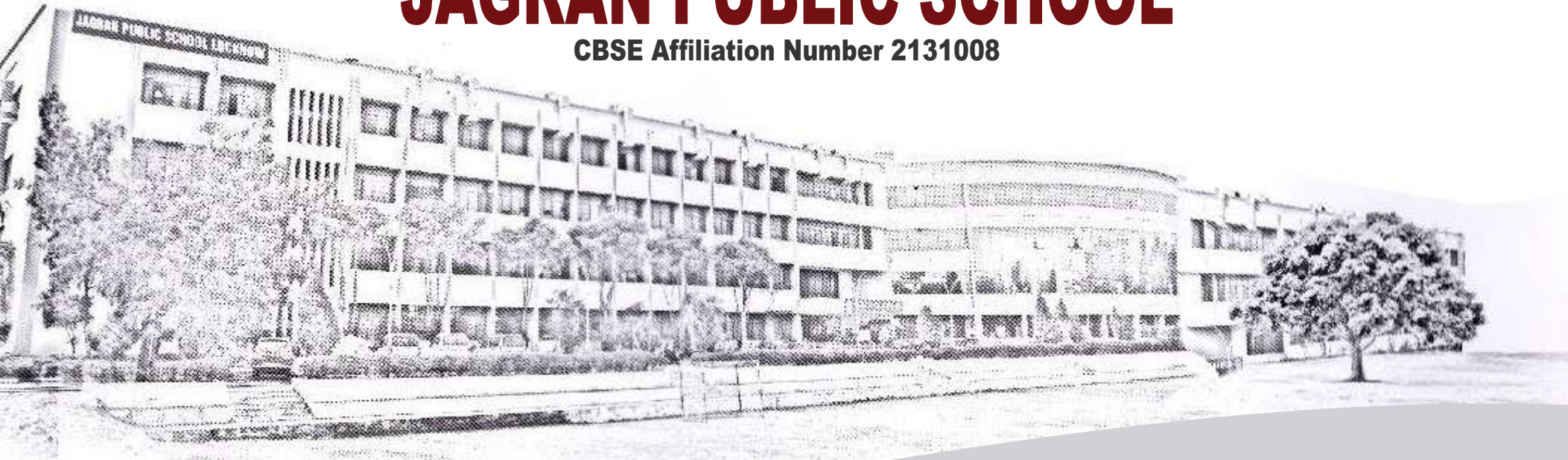

# CHAIRMAN'S Message

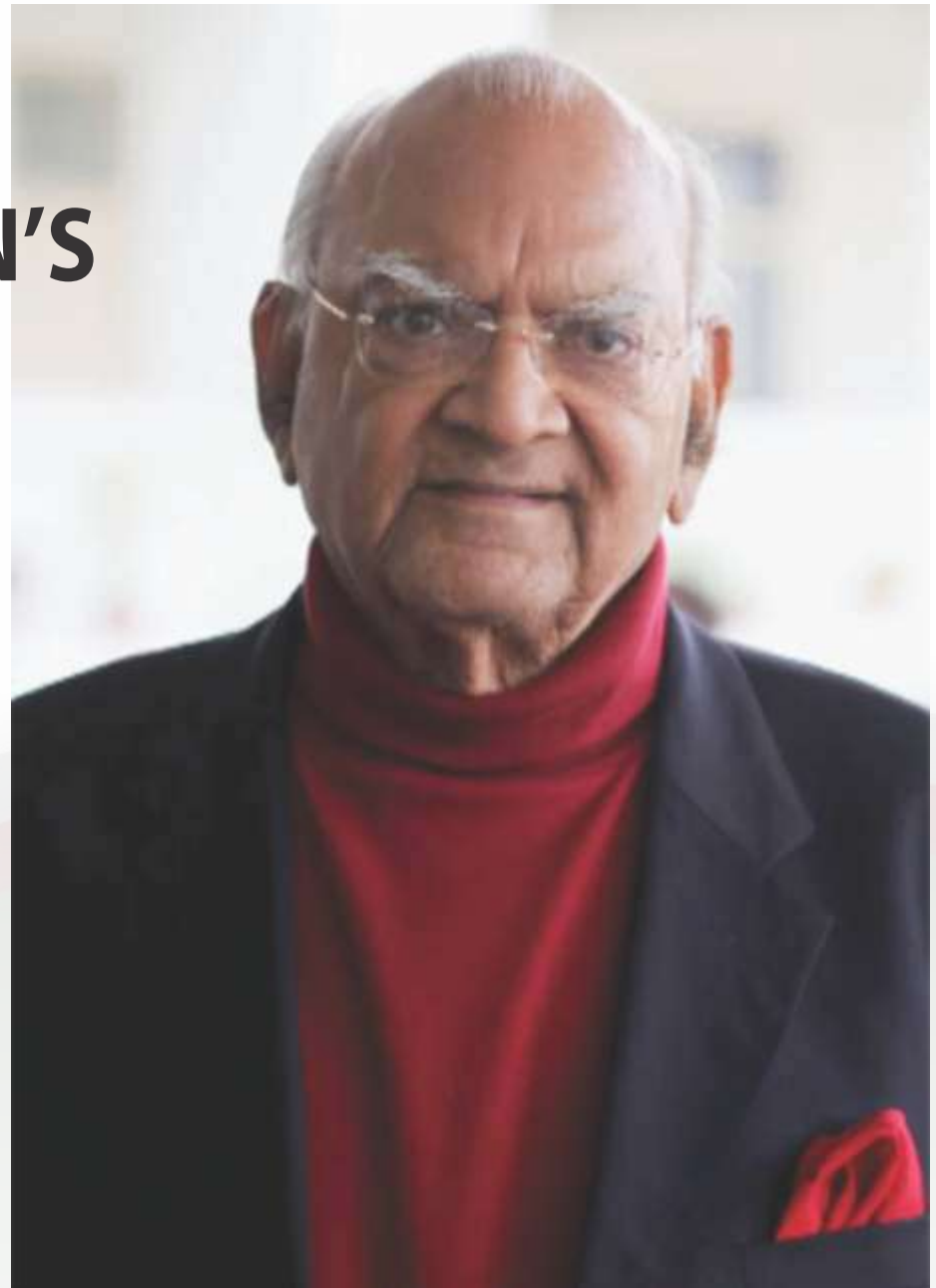

# ACADEMICS

The school is divided into 5 functional areas, each headed by a co ordinator in charge:

Pre Primary	Play Group, LKG, UKG
Primary	I-V
Middle	VI-VIII
Senior	IX-X
Senior Secondary	XI-XII

The medium of instruction is English.

- ▶ The Pre Primary prepares the child to attain three skills of Reading, Writing and Remembering. The teaching is child-centric, activity-based and involves a lot of art and craft. The subjects taught are English, Hindi, Mathematics, General Knowledge, Art & Craft, Value Education, Music and Yoga. Two big functions are held for this section, Phulwari and Udaan.
  - ▶ The Primary classes build up on the skills provided in the Pre Primary School. Environmental Sciences and General Science are added to the core subjects of English, Hindi and Mathematics. The focus is on spelling, sentence construction, following class and school rules, simple mathematical operations and values. They are taught how to handle computers, how to select books from the library, how to help fellow students. In addition to this, they can learn music from the Shankar Mahadevan Academy if interested. We have our own Music, Dance, Yoga and Physical Education classes.
  - ▶ The Middle School has English, Hindi, Science, Mathematics, Social Science, Computers, Sanskrit, Physical Education, Yoga, Music and Dance.
  - ▶ In the Senior Section, we have the following subjects: English, Hindi, Maths, Science, Social Studies and Computer Application.
- School offers the following three streams in Classes XI & XII:
- ▶ **Science:** English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics and Hindi/Computer/ Painting/Vocal Music/Physical Education.
  - ▶ **Commerce:** English, Business Studies, Accountancy, Economics, Hindi/Computer/ Painting/Vocal Music/Physical Education/Maths
  - ▶ **Humanities:** English, History, Political Science, Economics, Geography/Hindi/ Painting/ Vocal Music/ Physical Education

## VISUAL & Performing Arts

- › We have regular periods scheduled for the Visual Arts like Drawing, Painting, Photography, Rangoli Making and craft work. The work done by the students is displayed at the Annual Exhibition.
- › In the Performing Arts, we have Vocal & Instrumental Indian Music, Dance, Theatre, Public Speaking and Debating. The school has exclusively designed Art, Dance and Music Rooms with all kinds of musical instruments and trained teachers to develop these skills. The School Orchestra Shloka has won several trophies in Music.
- › We also have the **Shankar Mahadevan Academy** teaching music systematically to students of Classes LKG to IV. The curriculum is provided exclusively by the Academy.



## CLUBS & Societies

As the children grow up, they become aware of their inherent potential. We have a number of Clubs and Societies which provide students an opportunity to learn about their dominant interests through doing things, organizing events and activities in a chosen field.

Students can choose from a wide range of activities like Quizzing, Debating, Model United Nations, Mock Courts, Theatre, Cybernetics, First Aid, Community Service, Adventure Sports and Robotics.

Apart from the regular Clubs & Societies, the school has an Alumni Association, JSCIT – the IT Club, GOBOT – the Robotics Society, the Editorial Board and the JPS Art Society.

# WORK Experience

In every Academic Year, each student is allotted an activity for hands on experience. Generally, one activity is given to each class so that the children can learn from each other as well as from their trainers. The following activities are held in the school:

# HOUSE SYSTEM

The students are divided into four Houses at the time of Admission. The four Houses are:

Golden Wings	(Gold) with the motto Happiness, Optimism & Intellect
Blue Birds	(Blue) with the motto Confidence, Intelligence & Faith
Green Leaves	(Green) with the motto Growth, Harmony & Energy
Red Roses	(Red) with the motto Strength, Power & Passion

This forms the basis for healthy competition at all three levels: Sub Junior, Junior and Senior in Sports as well as in Co curricular activities.

Each House is put in charge of a House Master, Captain, Vice Captain, Sports Captain and three House Prefects.

The system encourages participation, team work and community responsibility.





## WORKSHOPS

The school invites professionals from diverse fields like Aviation, Hotel Management, NGOs that work on Road Safety and Women Hygiene, Railway Officers, Theater Personalities to speak about their life and experiences. Students are expected to learn the value of genuine efforts when they are put in the right direction. The school is in the **Spic Macay** Circuit and accomplished musicians like Ustad Shakir Khan, Padmashree GCD Bharti and Pt Bholanath Mishra have performed before our students.

## STUDENT Counseling

The school has a professional Counselor who conducts counseling sessions on adolescent issues when required. In addition to this, several workshops and seminars are held round the year for students of Classes IX to XII. This is to provide career guidance to those who are not aware of all the opportunities that are available for them.

The school also conducts interactive workshops for parents as well. Parents must try to take advantage of these opportunities as many of us are not aware of all the possibilities that exist.



## CCTV CAMERAS

We have CCTV cameras all over the school and a dedicated worker tracks the images throughout the day. This is to ensure that your child is safe and secure.

# LABORATORIES

The school has huge laboratories in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computers. The laboratories have all the equipment and reagents needed to conduct experiments stipulated by the Board.



# SMART CLASSES

The school has ten Smart Classes which are used in rotation by all the subject teachers in all the classes. The content is aligned to the prescribed books by Tata Class Edge. We use technology to add value to the classes, not to replace them.



# LIBRARIES

The school has two spacious libraries with plenty of reading material suitable for all age groups and interests. One library is used by the Junior school and the other by the senior school.



## SPORTS & Health Education

The school aims at providing all round development which means that the child is expected to do well in studies but not at the expense of his health. Students are made to take part in organized games as per their Time Table. We have special coaches in Volley Ball, Football, Cricket and Basket Ball. The other games played in the school are: Table Tennis, Badminton, Kho Kho, Roller Skating and Handball.

Our students regularly go to play in the National Games every year after winning in the CBSE Cluster Meets. We take part in all major Tournaments at the District and Inter School level, whether it is the La Martiniere League, the Reliance Foundation Cup or the Avinash Chaturvedi Memorial Tournament.

The participation of each and every child is recorded as per CBSE norms, and fitness is an important part of life at Jagran Public School.

We have a separate Sports Day for the Junior School, Udaan apart from the Annual Athletic Meet for the Senior School.

## INFIRMARY

The school has an infirmary with a Nurse. A physician visits the Infirmary twice or three times a week, depending on the number of students who are sick. In cases where complicated or extensive treatment is required, we request the parents to take their wards home. The Infirmary basically provides First Aid and medication in cases of common cold, fever and attends to minor wounds and bruises.

# SCHOOL MAGAZINE & Newsletter

Our School Magazine **Jagriti** is released every year at the Annual Function. It is made entirely by the students. All the students of the school get a copy. There is no pleasure like seeing your name and photograph in the school magazine. In addition to this, we have our quarterly newsletter **Abhivyakti** that publishes the names of achievers of the school in various fields.



# PARENT Teacher Meeting

Parent Teacher Meetings are held on the second Saturday of every month. The parents of the Hostellers get to interact with the teachers on days when outings are scheduled. Sometimes, the marks that the child is scoring are not enough to understand the direction in which the child's life is moving. It is for this reason that Parents are advised to be in touch with the teachers.





# HOSTEL

where life begins & caring never ends!

## Eligibility:

Admission to the Hostel is given to:

- Bonafide students of Jagran Public School from Class VI. Students of class V can be considered if they are meritorious.
- The child has to be 10 years or more.
- If Parents/Guardians are in a transferable job, or a place outside Lucknow where good education is not available.
- Local Guardian should be a resident of Lucknow.

## Dormitories & Furniture

- The Boys and Girls are housed in separate wings on the third floor. The
- Hostel has 12 well-lit, spacious, properly ventilated, air cooled dormitories.
- There are separate Dining Areas for the Girls and the Boys.
- Mattresses, bed covers and pillows are provided.
- Each student is allotted an almirah cum study table. Unused items can be put inside the box beds.
- There are recreational rooms with television, water coolers, washrooms, change rooms with proper fittings.

## Food

Students are provided a well balanced diet that tastes like home food with milk and fruit. The Mess is vegetarian and food is prepared in the Hostel Kitchen under the supervision of staff who are available to attend to complaints during meal times. The resident students are served 5 meals per day.

## Care & Guidance

- TUTORIALS: School teachers and a few teachers from outside come to teach and clear the doubts of the residents every day, according to a Time Table. Evening classes are held every day.
- SUPERVISION: The students live under the constant supervision of the wardens and the hostel staff. The Principal also lives on the same floor and oversees the administration and discipline of the hostel. Coaches train the students in sports and games of their interest.

# HOSTEL

- ENTERTAINMENT: Students celebrate all the festivals and special events in the evening and holidays. They go for excursions and movie outings together. Occasionally, cultural evenings are organized in the hostel.
- COMMUNICATION: The students are not allowed to keep mobile phones. However, they are allowed to speak to their parents on fixed days through telephones that are available with the wardens. The parents can communicate with their wards through their wardens in emergencies. Parents are advised not to ring up the wardens sparingly.
- HEALTH CARE: There is an Infirmary with a Nurse to attend to minor ailments. A practicing doctor visits the hostel two to three times a week to examine the ailing students. Children suffering from major ailments are handed over to the local guardians for extensive treatment. The Infirmary gives First Aid and the doctor attends to residents suffering from common problems only.

## OUTINGS

Outings are given for the Summer Vacation, Winter Vacation, Dusshera, Eid, Moharram and Deepawali. If a child has to be taken for weddings, the parent must apply in advance to the Hostel Warden with a copy of the Wedding Card. Habitual late-comers will be gated if they do not improve.





## EXCURSIONS & Trips

We keep sending our students on Excursions and trips to various places. They go to places which are important from the point of view of history, religion or plain tourism. These trips require the consent of the parents and are organized during the vacation.

## CLASS PICNIC

Each class gets an opportunity to go for their class picnic, once a year. It is generally planned on a Sunday or a Holiday. We send them to the historical monuments of Lucknow, Water Parks, Excavation Sites, Picnic Spots, Camp Sites where there are facilities for adventure sports.



## MEDITATION & Value Education

We believe that meditation is very important to life. Not only does it teach our children how to cleanse their hearts but also helps them to focus on their academic growth. Value education is provided not through lectures but through assignments. The teacher then asks the children what they felt. Heartfulness makes activities like Helping The Old At Home more meaningful as the children feel a surge of positive energy while recalling the details of the activity in class.

# JPS PRE SCHOOL

A separate state of the art circular enclosure has been designed exclusively for the tiny tots of the Pre Primary Wing with spacious, airy and colourful classrooms, a huge Activity Centre with smart boards, television set and innumerable toys and teaching aids.

The age requirement for the various classes is as follows:

Play Group - 3 years on the 31st of March in the year admission is sought

Lower Kindergarten - 4 years on the 31st of March in the year admission is sought

Upper Kindergarten - 5 years On the 31st of March in the year admission is sought

There is no Entrance Test for Admission, just a meeting of the child and the parents with the Principal on a scheduled date.

There is a separate uniform and time schedule for the Pre Primary students.

We use standard play-way methods, phonetics, and art and craft to inculcate the basic skills of Reading, Writing and Recognition. The children are taught to converse in English by the time they are ready to graduate to CI-1

We have an exclusive graduation ceremony for children moving to Class I. Phulwari and Udaan are the two functions that are held for the Pre Primary Section. Transport facility is available on request.

The teachers are trained, loving and caring. The children enjoy the activities designed for them and learning happens in a fear-free and joyful atmosphere.



## TRANSPORT

School has a fleet of CNG buses that cover every corner of Lucknow. They follow the safety norms as prescribed by the District Transport. Seats in the school buses is limited and need to be applied in advance.

# HYBRID MODEL of Teaching

As schools enter a new normal during and after the Covid-19 pandemic, the words “hybrid model” have become new buzzwords in education. JPS Lucknow started using the hybrid model quite early and was the pioneer of online teaching in Lucknow.

The concept of a hybrid classroom involves few students coming to school in person and remaining students attending school via live-video technology. Thus the students who are online have the same access to the classroom as every student attending in person. The large classrooms ensure that the social distancing norm of 6 ft distance in between is followed within classrooms. All the preventive measures like thermal screening, sanitization, hand wash etc are in place as the health of students and staff members is primary.

Ample number of digital devices in each class, audio visual classrooms with enormous digital content, technically sound teachers and good internet connectivity means hybrid classes are hassle free.



## ONLINE events

JPS Lucknow has ensured that students are not deprived of co curricular activities even in the difficult times. The weekly schedule also features yoga, work activity classes, art & craft, instrumental music and vocal music. On weekends, hybrid/ online inter house activities are conducted for GK quiz, painting, solo singing, dance, debates, extempore and elocution.
